## CRIME SCENE ANALYSIS MYSTERY NOVEL REVIEW

Choose a mystery novel. It does not have to be a murder mystery but it may be if you wish. It may be either a true story or fiction.

Report: THIS IS NOT A BOOK REPORT ....

Two page minimum including the data chart. 12 font, double spaced, TNR or Arial

Purpose: Analyze how the mystery is set up. Does the evidence support the final conclusion of the book?

Part 1: Introduction; This is basically your work cited. Include author, publisher, date and title.

Part 2: 2 - 3 paragraphs summarizing the basic plot of the story.

Part 3: Presentation of the characters (chart). Make sure you identify them as victim, suspect, witness, investigator, etc. Give other pertinent information as well.

Part 4: Presentation of evidence (clues); chart form what it is who it incriminates

who it exonerates

Part 5: Conclusion: "Who done it"

who what were when why how according to the book.
